NATRIP Implementation Society (NATIS), an autonomous body constituted by Ministry of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises, Government of India for execution of National Automotive Testing and R&D Infrastructure Project (NATRIP), the largest and one of the most significant initiatives in Automotive sector so far which represents a unique joining of hands between the Government of India, a number of State Governments and Indian Automotive Industry to create a state-of-the-art Testing, Validation and R&D infrastructure in the Country.

The Project aims at creating core global competencies in Automotive sector in India and facilitate seamless integration of Indian Automotive industry with the world as also to position the Country prominently on the global automotive map.

- 2.1 Request for Proposals:
- 2.1.1 NATRAX invites proposals from Tyre Manufacturers, Remoulding Tyre Manufacturers, Tyre Dealers and Scrap Dealers ("Successful Bidder") for providing scrap tyres at NATRAX
- 2.1.2 NATRAX intends to select a Successful Bidder to provide Scrap Tyres through a competitive bidding through open invitation to bid, in accordance with the Segragated method procedure set out herein.

2.2 Pre-qualification

2.2.1 Password Protected Technical and Financial Proposals must be prepared in the prescribed formats and submitted to the below mentioned email addresses address:

2.3 Due diligence by Applicants

- 2.3.1 2.4.1 Applicants are encouraged to get informed about the Site Conditions of NATRAX conditions before submitting the Proposal by contacting or sending written queries to NATRAX's representative mentioned in Para 2.9 and attending a Pre-Proposal Conference on the date and time specified in Para 2.10.
- 2.3.2 Bidders shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of them proposals. NATRAX is not bound to accept any proposal and reserves the right to annul the selection process at any time prior to Contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the Bidders.

2.4 Availability of RFP Document

2.5 Validity of the Proposal

2.5.1 The Proposal shall remain valid for a period of not less than 120 days from the Proposal Due Date (the "PDD")

2.6 Brief description of the Selection Process

2.6.1 NATRAX has adopted a two-stage selection process (the "Selection Process") for evaluating the Proposals comprising the technical and financial bids, to be submitted in two separate "Password Protected" documents through email. In the first stage, a technical evaluation will be carried out as specified in Para 3.3. Based on this technical evaluation, a list





of short-listed applicants shall be prepared as specified in Para 3.21. In the second stage, a financial evaluation will be carried out as specified in Para 3.22. NATRAX shall follow Segragated Bid System i.e., there is no weight age for technical score in the final evaluation and the responsive technically qualified proposal with the lowest evaluated cost shall be selected.

- 2.6.2 The Bidder can quote for either any one (1) type of Tyre or all Types of tyres. The Bidders also have the freedom to quote for a single phase or all the phases as per Para 3.2.1.
- 2.6.3 Incomplete proposals or those received after the specified time and date or not fulfilling the specified requirement shall not be considered.
- 2.7 Currency for payment
- 2.7.1 All payments to the Successful Bidder shall be made in INR in accordance with the provisions of this RFP.

SECTION 3 Instructions to Bidders

Part 1

- 3.1 Definitions
- (a) "NATRIP" means the National Automotive Testing and R&D Infrastructure Project.
- (b) "NATRAX" means National Automotive Test Tracks
- (c) "NATIS" shall mean the NATRIP Implementation Society with whom through "NATRAX" the selected agency will sign the Contract for providing the services as per the terms and conditions of the contract and Terms of Reference (TOR) of this RFP.
- (d) "Selected Bidder" means any entity or associations of person who will be selected to provide the Services to NATRAX under the Contract.
- (e) "Contract" means the Contract signed by the Parties for this assignment.
- (f) "Project/Programme specific information" means such part of the Instructions to
- (g) Consultants used to reflect specific Project/Programme and assignment conditions.
- (h) "Day" means calendar day.
- (i) "Employer" means "NATRAX"
- (j) "Government" means the Government of India
- (k) "Instructions to Applicants" means the document which provides bidders with all information needed to prepare their proposals.
- (1) LOI means the Letter of Invitation being sent by Employer to the consultant.
- (m) "Personnel" means professionals and support staff provided by the Consultant and assigned to perform the Services or any part thereof;
- (n) "Proposal" means the Technical Proposal and the Financial Proposal.
- (o) "RFP" means the Request for Proposal prepared by NATRAX for the selection of "Selected Bidder", based on the RFP.
- (p) "Assignment / job" means the work to be performed by the agency pursuant to the Contract.

3.2 Scope of Work

- 3.2.1 NATRAX has completed construction of all the test tracks and is in the final stages of putting up barriers and side walls on the tracks. For this, NATRAX requires scrap tyres to be used on the test tracks to absorb impact during emergencies. This project shall be completed in 3 phases, spread out over a period of 36 months.

- 3.4 Number of Proposals
- 3.4.1 No Applicant shall submit more than one proposal.
- 3.4.2 Applicants will submit separate technical and financial Password Protected bids under this RFP.





- 3.5 Bidders are required to submit their Bids in two parts in a Password Protected PDF format, named as "Bid for RFP No. NATRAX/RFP/TT/ST/21/131" on the subject of the email, containing two separate Password Protected PDF document, as given below. The Password Protected bids shall be submitted at the mentioned email ids before the closure of bid submission date/time.
- 3.5.1 The first Password Protected document marked as "Technical Bid for RFP No. NATRAX/RFP/TT/ST/21/131" shall consist of all the technical details eligibility, commercial terms and conditions and documents sought in the NIQ/RFP along with the signed copy the NIQ/RFP document. Further, the Technical Bid must include a copy of the unfilled Financial Bid of the Bidder without any information on the prices
- 3.5.2 The second Password Protected document marked as "Financial Bid for RFP No. NATRAX/RFP/TT/ST/21/131" should consist of the Financial Bid duly filled and signed by an authorised person from the Bidder's.
- 3.5.3 The password of the documents shall be submitted by the bidders at the time of the Technical Bid opening and the Financial Bid Opening respectively.
- 3.5.4 The technical bids are opened at the first instance and evaluated. At the second stage, financial bids of only these technically acceptable offers are to be opened with prior intimation on the date and time for further scrutiny, evaluation, ranking & placement of order.
- 3.6 The bidders are expected to meet the minimum eligibility criteria as given in the "RFP Document". NATRAX will reject the bids that do not meet the minimum eligibility criteria as laid down, based on their submission along with the RFP documents even after the bid opening process is concluded.
- 3.7 The Contract shall be governed by NATRAX's <u>Special Conditions for Contract</u> (<u>SCC</u>) and all other relevant specification applicable.
- 3.8 All Bidders are hereby explicitly informed that "CONDITIONAL OFFERS" or "OFFERS WITH DEVIATIONS" from the conditions of Contract, the quotation not meeting the minimum eligibility criteria, technical specifications, or any other requirements as stipulated in the RFP documents are liable to be "REJECTED".

3.9 RFP Fee & Exemptions: -

- 3.9.1 This RFP is free of cost.
- 3.9.2 If registered under Startups and "Micro & Small Enterprises" (MSEs), supporting documents need to be submitted to avail exemption from Earnest Money, subject to verification of certificate.





- 3.9.3 For Startups and MSME, price benefit shall be given as per the guideline, at the discretion of NATRAX.
- 3.10 The Bidders are expected to carefully examine all the contents of the RFP documents including instructions, conditions, terms, specifications, drawings (if any), shall inspect the Site with prior notice to NATRAX and at Bidders own cost, acquaint himself with all local conditions, means of access to the work, nature of the work and all matters pertaining thereto & take them fully into account before submitting their offer. Failure to comply with the requirements as detailed in these documents shall be at the Bidder's own risk. Bids which are not responsive to the requirements of the RFP will be rejected.
- 3.11 While all efforts have been made to avoid errors in drafting of the RFP documents, the Bidder is advised to check the same carefully. No claim on account of any errors detected in the RFP documents shall be entertained.
- 3.12 The Bidder shall carry out all the work strictly in accordance with Specification, Standard Practices and instructions of NATRAX or NATRAX's representative and deviation on any account will not be permitted. If in the opinion of NATRAX, changes have to be made in the design and it desires the Bidder to carry out the same. The decision of NATRAX in such cases shall be final and shall not be open to arbitration.
- 3.13 The successful Bidder is bound to carry out associated work necessary for the completion of the job even though such items are not included in the quantities and drawings to achieve end results and deemed to be priced in the other items. No claim on this account shall be entertained.
- 3.14 The successful Bidder should make his own arrangement to obtain all materials required for the work.
- 3.15 Addendum / Corrigendum (if required) to the RFP may be issued prior to the date of opening of the Bid to clarify or to intimate any changes/modifications etc. All such addendum / corrigendum shall be treated as an integral part of the RFP.
- 3.16 Any effort by a Bidder to influence NATRAX or any of its functionaries in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of RFPs and in decisions concerning award of contract, may result in rejection of the Bid.
- 3.17 In order to afford prospective bidders, reasonable time for preparing their Quotes after taking into account such amendments, NATRAX may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids.





- 3.18 Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bids and recommendations concerning the award of Contract shall not be disclosed to Bidders or other persons not officially concerned with such process.
- 3.19 NATRAX reserves the right to accept / reject or modify any bids, and to annul the RFP process and reject all quotations, at any time prior to award of Contract, or to divide the Contract between/amongst Bidders without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligations to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for NATRAX's action. Any bidder not following Instructions to Bidders stands rejected.

3.20 Bid Opening Details:

- 3.20.1 The Bids will be opened at NATRAX HUB office at the date and time through online mode only mentioned in RFP / corrigendum in the presence of Bidders or their duly authorized representatives, who choose to remain present at the time of opening the Bids.
- 3.20.2 A letter of authorization shall be submitted to NATRAX, through email, by the Bidder's representative before the opening of Bids.
- 3.20.3 It is advisable for the bidders to be present for the bid opening as the password of the bid documents shall be shared by the bidders at the time of bid opening only. No other way of submission of the passwords shall be accepted by NATRAX. However, Absence of bidders or their duly authorized representatives shall not impair the legality of the bid opening process.
- 3.20.4 The rate should be quoted both in words and figures on our prescribed format duly signed & stamped by the bidder, incase any discrepancy, word will be preferred. All statutory deductions shall be applicable while releasing payments. All corrections and overwriting should be initialed by the Bidder.

3.21 TECHNICAL BID EVALUATION

- 3.21.1 **NATRAX** shall follow the **Segregated bid evaluation** system (No bearing of technical score in the financial bid evaluation and L-1 in the financial bid shall be deemed as successful bidder) to determine the successful bidder. (Bidders may also refer the SCC)
